Properties:

AKEMI® Ceramics Care Cleaner is a concentrated, acid-free cleaning agent containing non-ionic surfactants, auxiliary agents, odorous substances and solvents. The product is free of phosphates and lyes. The surfactants contained in the cleaner are in accordance with the laws presently governing surface-active substances and are biologically degradable.

Application areas:

AKEMI® Ceramics Care Cleaner is designed to remove light soiling in a fast and simple manner, e.g. light films of oil or grease and normal dirt on fine stoneware, clinker and ceramic surfaces and the like. The surfaces are cleaned without leaving any streaks. Care Cleaner can be used in cleaning machines.

Instructions for use:

- 1. Mix 1-2 tablespoons (10-20 ml) of Care Cleaner in 10 litres of water. If a cleaning machine is being used, add double the amount of Care Cleaner.
- 2. Clean the surfaces using a damp cloth or mop.
- 3. Remove surplus cleaning water with a cloth or mop.

Special notices:

- Care Cleaner may not be used on plastics which are sensitive to solvents or rubber. If you are in doubt, try the product out on an inconspicuous place.
- In the case of heavier soiling, use AKEMI® Ceramics Cement Film Remover, AKEMI® Ceramics Intensive Cleaner or AKEMI® Stone Cleaner.
