Properties:

AKEMI® Cotto Wax Polish Classic is a fast-drying product made out of waxes and synthetic resins dissolved in hydrocarbons. The polish gives the treated surfaces a lustre and intensifies the colour tone considerably.

Application areas:

AKEMI® Cotto Wax Polish Classic is used as a final care measure for flooring and stairs indoors which are made of cotto, terracotta, terres quites, clay or brick slabs and the like. It is applied after the surfaces have been pretreated with AKEMI® Cotto Initial Cleaner, AKEMI Stone Cleaner or after impregnation with AKEMI® Cotto Protector W.

Instructions for use:

- 1. Clean the surface thoroughly with AKEMI® Cotto Initial Cleaner or AKEMI® Stone Cleaner first and then let it dry.
- 2. The best working temperature is 15-25°C. Do not forget to turn of underfloor heating in good time.
- Apply the polish sparingly with a cloth or in the case of larger surfaces with a floor mop.
- 4. Apply several times if the surface is particularly absorbent.
- If the surface has become dull, it can be given an excellent polish. Polish it using a soft cloth or - in the case of larger surfaces - a white nylon pad and a single-disc floor polisher.
- 6. Afterwards, AKEMI® Cotto Natural Soap Cleaner is ideal for general cleaning purposes.

Special notices:

- The product is not suitable for glazed surfaces.
- If there are any objects in the immediate area of treatment which are sensitive to solvents (e.g. various plastics, rubber, painted surfaces), they must be protected.
- The product jellifies at temperatures below 10°C and becomes almost solid below 0°C.
- If it has been stored in a cold place, it is necessary to store it a temperature above 15°C for a time before using it.
- Only apply thin layers of Cotto Wax Polish Classic; if the layer is too thick, the polishing results will be poor.
- AKEMI® Wax Remover is ideal for removing cotto wax layers.
- Use AKEMI® »Liquid Glove« to protect your hands when using the product.
- The product is registered at the Federal Environmental Agency (Umweltbundesamt) under the number 12570031.
- To ensure proper waste disposal, empty the container completely before disposing of it.
